The question would create a regulated system so adults could access psychedelic therapy under the guidance of a licensed facilitator at approved and licensed therapy centers. It would also remove criminal penalties for adult who possess and grow these substances for their own use. **(SPLIT SAMPLE B: The ballot question would not permit any retail sale of natural psychedelic substances).**
